A female sprint ace, Fukushima became the first Japanese runner in 100 to compete in an Olympics in 56 years at the Beijing Games in '08. She qualified through the first round in 100 at the '09 world championships, which was the first feat for a Japanese in 77 years at a world championships or an Olympics. Fukushima set national records both in 100 (11.21) and 200 (22.89), while he earned double titles at the Asiad in '10, which was also the first feat for a Japanese. Fukushima earned a gold medal in 200 at the '11 Asia championships. She competed in two events at the '12 London Olympics. She completed double titles for the fourth consecutive year at nationals.

Doi notched a national junior high school record of 11.61 in 100 in her senior year. She finished fourth at nationals, competed at world youth and triumphed at the inter-high school meet in her high school freshman season. She set a national junior record of 11.43 in 100 and marked a then national youth record of 23.83 in 200 in her second year. Doi finished runner-up in 100 at nationals and became the youngest sprinter in the post-war era competing in the 4x100 relay at age 16 in the same year. She completed treble title at the inter-high school meet, national athletic meet and Japan junior as senior. This year, Doi ran in 23.63 in 200 for a national junior second-best record at the Shizuoka International and finished second in 100 at nationals, while she advanced to the semifinals in 100 and was sixth in the 4x100 relay at world junior.

Matsumoto earned a title in 400 at nationals and notched a 53.59 mark, a fifth-best record for a high school athlete two weeks later this year. She finished second in 400 and failed to qualify through the semis in 800 yet she exhibited some descent performance in 4x400 relay at the inter-high school meet also this year. She triumphed in 800 at an national junior high school championships. Matsumoto finished sixth in 400 tying with the nation's fifth-best record for a freshman of 55.34 at the inter-high school meet. She ran in 54.28 in 400, also fifth-best record for a second-year athlete in June. Matsumoto was sixth at nationals and world youth while she was fifth both in 400 and 800 at the inter-high school meet and was second in 800 at the national athletic meet also in her junior season.

Aoyama was third in 200 both at the national junior high school meet and junior Olympics in her senior season. She triumphed in 200 boys B race with a 24.12 mark, which was the fifth-best record for a high school freshman, at the national athletic meet. She set a Japan youth record of 23.78 in a 200 heat at world youth while she made top-eight finishes in three different events in her second year. She was fifth in 100 and third in 400 with a Japan youth record of 53.40 in the same season. This year, Aoyama finished eighth in 200 and runner-up in 400 at nationals. She was third in 100 and grabbed titles in 200 and 400 at the inter-high school meet while she set a personal best of 11.83 in the 100 semis.

She marked 11.73, which was then the 10th-best high school record, while she finished sixth in 100 and helped her team win a title in 4x100 relay at the inter-high school meet in her senior season. In '13, Fujimori, representing Aoyama Gakuin University, triumphed at the Kanto inter-collegiate and was fifth at nationals. She set a personal best of 11.68 in a victory at the national collegiate individual championship, and was a member of the 4x100 team that won a silver medal at the Asian championships in the same year. She was selected on the team for the world relays and was third at nationals this year.

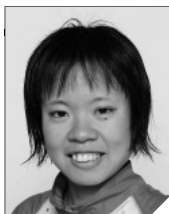

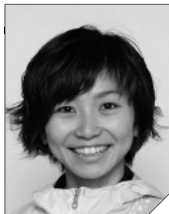

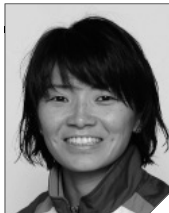
