

2011 Asian Championships Statistics – Women's 800m

Margarita Matsko could win first gold medal for KAZ and if successful she will be the fifth woman to win both Asian Games and Asian Championships.

If Tintu Luka wins, it will be IND's first gold since 1995 in this event.
